Role and Responsibilities

- Demonstrate positive safety behaviors in support of MPR “Road to Zero” injury reduction culture
- Maintain levels and consistency of operating equipment lube, oil and grease to ensure proper function and longevity of equipment
- Assist with the troubleshooting of general equipment problems, specifically with equipment reliability
- Help identify critical equipment in all areas and assure lubrication, parts and procedures are accurate to address reliability issues
- Provide technical recommendations for any equipment issues and advise on necessary upgrades to machines to extend equipment life and increase reliability and/or efficiency
- Help manage the lube shop’s lube, oil and grease inventory and ensure the shop is organized
- Ensure all maintenance generated paperwork conforms to MPR procedures and external guidelines
- Assist Maintenance Technicians in equipment Maintenance repairs when required
- Responsible for installation, troubleshooting, modification, repair, testing, calibration, commissioning and maintenance
- Liaise with other maintenance trades, operators, and production leads regarding mechanical problems and opportunity for improvements of efficiency and safety
- Evaluate operating data to conduct adjustments to products, instruments, or equipment
- Control downtime by informing production team of routine preventive maintenance techniques and monitoring compliance
- Support the pressure equipment Integrity Management System, Management of Change, RAM, and Problem Solving Decision Making processes
- Analyze and make recommendations based on equipment oil samples
- Additional duties as required
